SHELTERHOUSE SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS Hunt has created and is the owner of a software product known as ShelterHouse Software (hereinafter referred to as the ShelterHouse Software).

AND WHEREAS the Licensee wishes to purchase a license to utilize the ShelterHouse Software.

NOW the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. Hunt hereby grants to The Licensee, a personal, non-transferable and non-exclusive right to use the ShelterHouse Software and all associated documentation provided with it, solely in object code format and solely for its own internal business purposes. The Licensee shall be allowed to use the ShelterHouse Software from a local network file server and accessed by multiple local network desktop computers.

2. The Licensee shall be required to pay a license fee to Hunt upon the initial purchase of the ShelterHouse Software. The said license will be for a period of one year from the date upon which the ShelterHouse Software is installed. The license will automatically terminate following that term unless the Licensee pays to Hunt the then current annual license fee for the ShelterHouse Software. Upon such payment, the term and provisions of this license will be extended for a further one year period and extension of the license term may be repeated indefinitely.

3. Hunt agrees to provide the Licensee with Software Support of the ShelterHouse Software and related materials. "Software Support" is defined as:
 - (a) Free e-mail support on the use of the ShelterHouse Software for the first 90 days, from the date of this agreement;
 - (b) The correction of program errors in the ShelterHouse Software as and when reported by the Licensee. Such correction will occur in a timely fashion

namely, six (6) weeks at most, following receipt of the Licensee's program error report;

- (c) The supply of software fixes/upgrades to the ShelterHouse Software and related materials, for the period of this limited term license, as and when such fixes/upgrades become available (provided however, in the event that the Licensee requests an enhancement or change to the ShelterHouse Software to add a new feature or application, such enhancement shall be subject to the payment of a fee by the Licensee to Hunt).
4. The ShelterHouse Software contains copyrighted material trade secrets and other proprietary material. The Licensee agree that it will not:
- (a) copy the Software except that it may make one copy of the Software only for backup purposes;
 - (b) copy any of the written materials for any purpose;
 - (c) modify, rent, lease, loan, create derivative works based upon, copy or distribute the ShelterHouse Software in whole or in part;
 - (d) assign this Agreement or transfer, export or grant a sublicense of the ShelterHouse Software or the license contained herein to any other party unless authorized by Hunt in writing;
 - (e) reverse engineer, de-compile or disassemble the ShelterHouse Software or otherwise reduce it to a human perceivable form;
 - (f) use the ShelterHouse Software except as authorized herein; and

- (g) permit third parties to use the ShelterHouse Software in any way that would constitute a breach of this Agreement.
5. Hunt is the owner of all intellectual property rights in the ShelterHouse Software, related written materials, logos, names and other support materials furnished to the Licensee in this package. No title to the intellectual property in the ShelterHouse Software, the documentation, magnetic media or any other material provided therewith is transferred to the Licensee by this Agreement.
 6. The Licensee expressly acknowledges and agrees that the use of the ShelterHouse Software is at its own risk. Hunt does not warrant or make any representations regarding the use or the results of the use of the ShelterHouse Software or related information in terms of their correctness, accuracy, reliability or otherwise. No oral or written information or advice given by Hunt or a Hunt representative shall create a warranty or in any way increase the scope of this warranty. In no event shall Hunt be liable to the Licensee or to any third party for any direct, indirect, special or consequential damages, whether foreseeable or not, even if advised of the possibility thereof. This limitation and exclusion applies irrespective of the cause of action, including but not limited to breach of contract, negligence, strict liability, tort or any other legal theory and shall survive a fundamental breach.

7. Hunt is not responsible for problems which may occur as a result of any incompatibility between the ShelterHouse Software and any other software or hardware. The Licensee assumes responsibility for the selection of the ShelterHouse Software to achieve its intended purposes, for making backups of its data regularly, and for choosing, maintaining and matching its hardware, operating system software and other applications software. Hunt cannot guarantee the Licensee uninterrupted service or the correction of any errors.
8. The Licensee shall indemnify and hold Hunt harmless from any and all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including reasonable fees of lawyers and other professionals) arising out of or in connection with its use of the ShelterHouse Software. The Licensee shall promptly notify Hunt of any such claim.
9. This Agreement is effective until terminated. The Licensee may terminate this Agreement at any time by destroying all copies of the ShelterHouse Software and related material. Hunt may terminate this license without notice to the Licensee if it fails to comply with any of its terms. Any such termination by Hunt shall be in addition to and without prejudice to such rights and remedies as may be available, including injunctive and other equitable remedies. Upon receipt by The Licensee of written notice of termination from Hunt or termination by the Licensee, the Licensee shall immediately:
 - a) cease using the ShelterHouse Software;

- b) return to Hunt the ShelterHouse Software and all written documentation and all magnetic media provided to the Licensee (or destroy all copies thereof in its possession); and
 - c) within 5 days thereafter, provide Hunt with a written confirmation that The Licensee has complied with the foregoing. The provisions of this Agreement shall survive termination of this Agreement.
10. From time to time, in Hunt's sole discretion, updates may be made to the ShelterHouse Software. Updates will be available to the Licensee without cost, and any such updates shall be deemed to be part of the ShelterHouse Software and be subject to this Agreement. Provided however, in the event that the Licensee requests an enhancement or change to its ShelterHouse Software to add a new feature or application, such enhancement shall be subject to the payment of a fee by the Licensee to Hunt.
11. This is the entire agreement between the Licensee and Hunt pertaining to the Licensee' right to use the ShelterHouse Software and related documentation, and supercedes all prior, collateral or contemporaneous oral or written representations or agreement regarding such subject matter. In the event that one or more of the provisions is found to be illegal or unenforceable, this Agreement shall not be rendered inoperative but the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario, Canada. No amendment to or modification of this


Agreement will be binding unless in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of Hunt.
